These permits are valid for 12 months and a Property Inspection is required. **To be an approved breeder the fee and 1 yr registration must be paid**

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CAT OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Cat Act 2011 & the Cat Local Laws state that cat owners must ensure their cat:

- Wears a collar and a registration tag when in a public place
- All cats aged six months and over must be registered, sterilised and micro chipped (*Cat Act 2011*)
- Approved breeders must have suitable premises where cats can be bred in a safe & ethical way
- Only two cats permitted per property unless granted an exemption by the city
- Cats must be kept indoors between 8pm and 6am

Your registration fee;

- Reunites lost cats with their owners.
- Contributes to the maintenance of the Animal Management Facility
- Supports Ranger Services within the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder
- Cat registrations must be renewed prior to 1st November
- The City must be informed immediately of any change of details (i.e. deceased, ownership, address etc).
- Reduced fees apply upon proof of either current:
- i) Pensioner Concession Card;
- ii) Commonwealth Seniors Health Card with a WA Seniors card.
