# Materials that can contain Asbestos:

- Flat or corrugated sheeting
- Cement pipes
- Insulation
- Floor tiles
- Adhesives
- Roofing
- Textiles and textured paints

# Where can I dispose of Asbestos?

The Yarri Road Refuse Facility in Kalgoorlie-Boulder will accept asbestos.

**Address:** Lot 251 Yarri Road, Parkeston, WA

# Disposal Criteria:

## Asbestos must be:

- Separated from other waste
- Double wrapped and sealed
- Labelled with 'CAUTION ASBESTOS' in letters at least 50 mm high

## Provide a Building or Demolition Permit for:

- All waste disposal over 10m<sup>2</sup>
- The address where asbestos originates from for disposals over 1m<sup>3</sup>

## Please provide:

- Address of where asbestos is coming from prior to disposal
- Notice 24 hours prior to asbestos disposal
- Proof of residency

## Please note:

- A licensed asbestos removalist should be used
- Unwrapping of packages on-site is not permitted
