Purchase of Artworks Policy

Purpose

The City endorses the purchase of art pieces in accordance with budgeted funds from entries to the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulders annual Art Prize Awards.

The purchasing of any items is to be undertaken by a panel of three Elected Members as nominated by the Mayor.

Statement

With the coordinating of the annual City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Art Exhibition, Council allocates funds in each financial year to purchase one or more of the entries received.

The procedure for purchasing art pieces is as follows:

1. A panel of three Elected Members as nominated by the Mayor will formally consider all Art Prize entries of which Council has first selection prior to public viewing.
2. Each of the three Elected Members selects five entries and ranks them in priority order.
3. Elected Members will compare and review their preferences to decide on final purchases(s).
4. There is no ruling on the number or type of selection being made however, the purchasing should not exceed the annual budget allocation for the purchasing of artworks as determined by the Council.
