All trainees and apprentices are provided with an on-boarding program that supports their entry into the workforce. Mentors are provided to assist in ensuring trainees are supported during their career journey with the City.

Traineeships are for a period of 12 months and at the end of this you will have achieved your certificate in your chosen field.

Apprenticeships

An apprentice is employed with the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder for four years. During this time, you will work alongside experienced qualified tradespeople.

Formal off-the-job training will be provided through Central Regional TAFE and at the end of the apprenticeship you will obtain a Trade Certificate in your chosen field.

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First Nations Traineeships


The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder commenced a First Nations Traineeship program in 2022. The program is designed to provide trainees with mentoring support from City mentors who have undertaken a specific Cultural Training Awareness and Mentoring program.

When do applications open?

The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder's Traineeships and Apprenticeships open at the end of the calendar year with the successful candidates to be offered positions in January/February the following year.
