THE EARLY YEARS

WHAT ARE THE EARLY YEARS?

The moment a child is born all of their experiences are learning experiences.

The opportunities and encouragement we give our children in their first eight years of life shape the person they grow up to be.

Even before they are born, babies are ready to learn. Their brains grow faster in the first two years of their life than at any other time.

How our children grow up is not just about how they are cared for at home. It is also about how we in our communities help each other to raise our kids.

INTERESTING BRAIN FACTS

Even before we are born we are ready to learn.

Our brains grow faster in the first two years of life than at any other time

The human brain takes in and organises more information in a day than a computer is capable of in a month.

When your baby imitates your facial expression it triggers the emotion in their brain and bodies too.

By the time a child begins Kindy, their brain has reached its full size but it won't stop developing until the mid-20s.

More than 60% of a babies energy is consumed by the brains every day development.

WHAT IS THE EARLY YEARS STRATEGY?

The Early Years Strategy in Kalgoorlie Boulder (KBEYSG) is committed to nurturing the wellbeing of young children, their families and caregivers to build a stronger community, now and in the future.

Our Early Years Strategy is about encouraging the community to find new ways of working together to help children get the best start in life.

To ensure that our children get off to the best start, the Kalgoorlie Boulder Early Years Strategy Group was formed and meets once a month. Led by industry members in childcare, education, health and community development it is our aim to bring the community together through the vested interest of our children and to develop and implement improvements for the enrichment of our families and children within our community.



EDUCATION AND CARE SERVICES

A description of the different childcare services that exist in Kalgoorlie Boulder are listed below. For parent who work, volunteer, need to attend appointments or simply need a time out are encouraged to make contact and tour the facilities. Your child's social development can be enriched by attending childcare too. Please refer to page 17 for a full list of the childcare operators and organisations in our city. To register for child care subsidy you will be required to contact your local Centrelink office or phone 136 150 for more information.

FAMILY DAY CARE

Family Day Care services provide care and developmental activities for small groups of children in the homes of the family daycare educators. Care is flexible and can be matched to suit each family's needs and may be available on weekends or overnight if needed. Family Day Care services may provide care for children up to 12 years of age. Registered Family Day Care Centres offer government subsidies for those who are eligible.

CRECHE

Creche is a short term or one off care provided for children while parents participate in an activity, meeting or other event on the same premises. You will generally find Creche facilities at Gyms/Health Clubs or when you are attending a specific training sessions held within the facility.



IN HOME CARE

In Home Care is a flexible form of childcare where an approved educator provides care in the child's home. In Home Care may be available for families who do not use a standard child care service or where their child care needs cannot be met by an existing service. To receive In Home Care, families must meet **both** the requirements of the Child Care Subsidy and the assessment criteria for In Home Care:

Assessment Criteria for In Home Care

Families must demonstrate that other child care options are not suitable **and** have one or more of the following assessment criteria:

- Parents or carers working **non-standard or variable hours**, outside normal child care service hours
- **Geographical isolation** from other child care, particularly in rural or remote locations based on the ARAI Score of their home
- The family has **complex or challenging needs** and other approved child care services are not able to meet the needs of the child or the family



CENTRE BASED CARE

Centre based care includes services that provide quality all day or part-time care for children aged 0-12 years. Private operators, local councils, and community/not-for-profit incorporated organisations may run these services.

Centre Based 0-6 years (Occasional Care)

Occasional Care is a unique service which supports families by providing flexible care for children from birth to school age. Families can access Occasional care regularly or irregularly. Occasional care allows the flexibility to leave children for short periods of time in an early childhood learning environment to socialise and interact with other children. Usually you are expected to provide your children's meals and formula. Government subsidies are available via registered care providers.

Centre Based 6-12 years (Outside School Hours Care)

Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) services provide care mainly for primary school children before and/or after school and during school holidays. In some services, care is also provided on pupil free days and public holidays. Usually, your child is transported to and from school via a private bus under the care of certified child care personnel. Government subsidies are available via registered care providers.

Centre based 6-12 years (Vacation Care)

Vacation care services provide care, including creative indoor and outdoor activities during the school holidays for primary school children. Fees often include excursions and some meals. Government subsidies are available via registered care providers.

WHEN CAN MY CHILD START SCHOOL?

WHAT IS FORMAL EDUCATION?

Parents and guardians are the first educators of their children who then progress through Early Education and Care Services followed by Formal Education. Formal Education starts from the year your child can attend Kindergarten.

Children must be four by the 30th of June in the year they go to Kindergarten and five by June 30th in the year they attend Pre-Primary.

To enrol your child in any Formal Education program please contact your choice of school directly. Some schools may have limitations on enrolments as geographical boundaries or zones regulate some schools.

Currently, parents in Kalgoorlie Boulder have the choice of Government, Independent or Private schools with Religious affiliations.

SUPPORTING CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

PLAYGROUP

A playgroup is a group of parents or carers and their young children who meet regularly for interaction and fun. Playgroups are for children from birth to school age and usually each playgroup meets on the same day of every week for approximately 2 hours. Playgroups are run by the members themselves and meet in a variety of venues depending on the needs of the group and availability of a suitable premise.


Through Playgroup, mothers, fathers, grandparents and other caring adults find the opportunity for;

- Meeting new friends
- Reducing isolation and loneliness
- Developing a new self-confidence
- Having special time with their children
- Discovering new ideas for extra fun at home
- Developing a greater understanding of children and what being a parent and carer is all about
- Building a support network of friends and social contacts.

Through Playgroup children will;

- Have fun with play activities
- Make new friends
- Discover new experiences
- Find out about the world around them
- Gain self confidence and develop self expression
- Learn how to get along with other people
- Be given opportunities to enhance all areas of their physical, social, emotional and cognitive development.





CHILDREN'S LIBRARY SERVICES

All state and community libraries have a Children's section. Parents are encouraged to come along and bring their children so they are introduced to books and storytelling from a young age. Many libraries run storytelling and craft sessions throughout the week, usually different age groups are catered to with separate sessions dates and times.

These programs are designed for young children and their families. Sessions generally include oral stories, story readings, singing and nursery rhyme activities.

Storytelling sessions are designed to promote a love of books and stories and helps develop language, literacy and brain development.

COMMUNITY TOY LIBRARIES

Community Toy Libraries offer a wide variety of toys, games and books for loan. Generally you have to become a member of the library before you can borrow any items.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES FOR FAMILIES

Call upon your village in times of physical and environmental stress for support and assistance. Kalgoorlie Boulder is a generous community and there are many different charitable organisations who can provide care, referrals and other kinds of support to help you raise your family.

PARENTING CONNECTION WA

Parenting Connection WA is a new approach to supporting parents in many communities around the State, including the Goldfields-Esperance.

Anglicare WA and Ngala are partnered to bring their parenting knowledge and skills to nine regions across the State under one umbrella.

Parenting Connection WA is led by Anglicare WA and Ngala, with partner Wanslea leading the local project activity in two of the regions.

Its mission is for parents to have the knowledge, skills and confidence to be the best parents they can be.

Parenting Connection WA will work with local communities, in Goldfields-Esperance, to identify particular needs, ensuring services are the right fit for that community.

A Parenting Partnership Coordinator will coordinate services across the region, based at the Anglicare WA office in Kalgoorlie.

WHAT ARE PEDIATRIC HEALTH SERVICES?

You will find a team of Allied Health professionals at your local hospital. They are a committed team of professionals working together to provide integrated assessment and intervention services for children of all ages. Generally the team will consist of the following;

SPEECH PATHOLOGY

A Speech Pathologist can assist children of all ages with a variety of problems including; stuttering, difficulties with speech sounds; or problems with both understanding and use of language. Speech Pathologists may also assist in feeding difficulties and dribbling problems.

SOCIAL WORKER

Generally you will find a Social Worker or an Aboriginal Liaison Welfare Officer at all major hospitals. They are there to assist inpatients and outpatients and their relatives with health and welfare related issues. The Social Work department provides services associated with carer support, practical welfare support and referrals, crisis support, grief counselling, and family support.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Occupational Therapists can assist children's development in areas of play, self-care, school readiness and engaging in school activities. Occupational Therapists specialise in working with children that may have difficulties with fine motor coordination skills or visual perception.

AUDIOLOGY

The Audiology Department provides assessment and management of hearing difficulties and associated ear problems such as: Ringing in the ears "Tinnitus" and middle ear infections "Otitis Media". Audiologists are also able to provide information on ear care and cleaning.

PHYSIOTHERAPISTS

Physiotherapists can assist the gross motor development of children in the following areas:


- Developmental delay
- Developmental coordination disorder
- Neurological disorders
- Orthopaedic problems
- Chest conditions

Services may involve assisting parents with the promotion of development milestones; developing specific muscle strength & endurance and developing programs for children with specific needs for active inclusion.

Physiotherapists can assist with the organisation of procurement of equipment, walking aids, resources and information.

DIETETICS DEPARTMENT

The Dietetics Department provides nutritional care to children in hospital and as needed, to outpatients. Major activities include evaluation, screening, counselling and education and support for parents of infants and children with nutritional concerns.




WHAT OTHER HEALTH SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE?

CHILD HEALTH CLINICS

Community Child Health Nurses work from various clinics throughout Kalgoorlie Boulder. They work with young families to assist and guide parents with the general well being and development of their child. The Child Health Nurses conduct routine health checks from the clinics and can act as a link between hospital, family GP's and other health professionals as required.

Community Health Nurses administer immunisations clinics and a variety of programs that are directed at assisting parents with the demands of adjusting to parenting.



DENTAL HEALTH

Most primary schools offer free basic dental care to school aged children from Pre-primary through to Year 12. The main emphasis of the School Dental Clinic is on prevention, oral health education and early intervention to fix dental problems.

CHILDREN WITH ADDITIONAL NEEDS

There are a wide range of services available to help people with disabilities in the Kalgoorlie Boulder region.

Most services offer advice and information that enable families to link in with the other services. Some services offer respite care which allows time out for a carer of a child with additional needs.

Child care can provide a much needed break for families caring for a child with additional needs. All children's services have access to an Inclusion Support Facilitator who can assist Early Childhood Educators.

VACCINATION IMMUNISATION SCHEDULE

Your local Child Health Nurse and General Practitioner can answer your questions about Immunisation.

All children aged from 6 months to less than 5 years should also receive the influenza vaccine each year.

Please speak to your immunisation provider to ensure your child receives all the vaccines they are eligible for.




