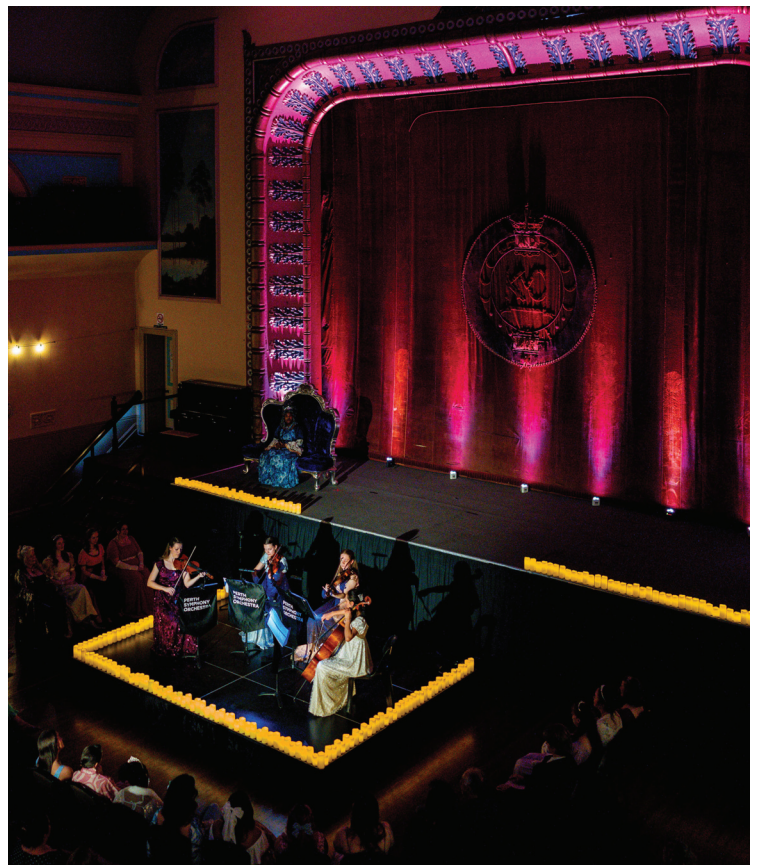
BE PART OF KALEIDOSCOPE 2026
