KALGOORLIE-BOULDER WALK *of* FAME



Nominations are now open for the Kalgoorlie-Boulder Walk of Fame. This award honours recipients for their significant and positive contribution to the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder and its people.

Recipients are also considered for the award due to the recognition they have brought to Kalgoorlie-Boulder nationally and internationally.

Each year, the Walk of Fame Working Group will consider at least one outstanding Kalgoorlie-Boulder individual. The recognition taking place with the unveiling of a plaque on Hannan Street in the Kalgoorlie CBD.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The nominee must have made a significant and positive contribution to the people and the region of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

ELIGIBILITY

- Nominees must reside or have resided in Kalgoorlie-Boulder.
- Nominations are for individuals only (groups are not eligible).

NOMINATION PROCESS

- Nominations are to be received by 3pm Friday, 11 November 2022. Late nominations will not be accepted.
- Nominations can be completed on the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder website www.ckb.wa.gov.au or hard copy forms are available at the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Administration Building, 577 Hannan Street, Kalgoorlie.

JUDGING

- Nominations are retained and reviewed in each award year thereafter.
- The working group will have the final decision and no other correspondence will be entered into.
- Lobbying of the working group or the Council is not acceptable and may result in the disqualification of the nomination.

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

Annual inductees will be announced at the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Australia Day event, held at Centennial Park on Thursday, 26 January 2023.



Australia Day

Reflect. Respect. Celebrate.

Each year one local citizen and one local community group or event in the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder are recognised as part of the Australia Day Awards.

Recipients are selected from people and groups who have made a noteworthy contribution during the current year, or given outstanding service to the local community over a number of years through active involvement.

There are six category awards:

- Citizen of the Year
- Young Citizen of the Year
- Senior Citizen of the Year
- Volunteer of the Year
- Community Group or Event of the Year

The Walk of Fame Inductee is also presented at the Australia Day event each year.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The winners will be judged on their active citizenship and:

- Significant contribution to the local community;
- Demonstrated leadership on a community issue relating to the enhancement of community life;
- A significant initiative which has brought about a positive change and added value to community life; and
- Inspiring qualities as a role model (individual or community group) for the community.

ELIGIBILITY

- Nominees should reside or work principally within the locality of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.
- Awards may be granted posthumously in recognition of recent achievements.
- Groups of people or couples will not normally be eligible except when meeting the criteria for a community group award.
- A person cannot receive the same award twice, but can be considered for another award.
- Unsuccessful nominees may be nominated in future years.
- Sitting members of State, Federal and Local Government are not eligible for nomination for work undertaken in their official capacity.

NOMINATION PROCESS

City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder invites nominations for the awards from community groups and residents towards the end of the previous calendar year.
