A social story for families visiting the Sunset Concert Series with young children on the autism spectrum.








I am planning to go to the Sunset Concert Series at Centennial Park.

After we park the car, it will only be a short walk to Centennial Park.





There will be lots of music and people around so sometimes it could be noisy.

If I have headphones, I could bring them with me and put them on if it gets too noisy.









Food trucks might be selling food so there will be lots of smells, some I might like and some I might not like.

If I don't like the smells I can walk away and sit somewhere else.







There could be some bright, flashing lights or smoke while the bands perform. I can look away if I do not like them.





There may even be roving entertainment or activities throughout the event.





Sometimes I might have to wait my turn while other children are doing the activity.

They will be wearing pink or yellow vests.
