

COVID-19 RECOVERY FUND APPLICATION

1. Information for all Applicants

The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder (City) has established a COVID-19 Recovery Fund for community and sporting organisations to access due to impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

For community groups and sporting organisations wishing to apply, they will need to demonstrate the impact of COVID-19 on their operations financially and the amount requested to be assessed. Applicants should consider the following before contacting the City:

- Operational costs;
- Other fees and charges from the City;
- Loss of income since the impacts of COVID-19 began in your community group or sporting organisation;
- Other funding and support applied for or received including JobKeeper and LotteryWest applications;
- The financial loss in relation to the above points; and
- The value of your request.

The COVID-19 Recovery Fund is not for costs unrelated to the impacts of COVID-19 such as the purchase of new equipment, future events etc.

1.1 Eligibility

Eligible organisations are defined as follows:

- Community groups that are not-for-profit or charitable organisations;
- Sporting organisations or projects sponsored under the auspices of a not-for-profit organisation;
- Applications demonstrating evidence of meeting City's Strategic Community Plan 2020-2030 outcomes;
- Of these nominated above, applicants must demonstrate that they have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

1.2 Assessment

Applications will be assessed based on level of information provided to support the applicant's request and suitability based on the aforementioned eligibility criteria. Applicants will need to demonstrate the impact of COVID-19 on their operations financially, and the amount requested to be assessed. Prior to applying applicants must contact the City to discuss.
