

FACT SHEET

USED TYRE DISPOSAL AT YARRI ROAD REFUSE FACILITY

Domestic Customers – used tyres generated as a result of household day-to-day use. Includes only motorcycle, car and 4WD tyres.

- Only residents of Kalgoorlie-Boulder are permitted to dispose of domestic tyres. Proof of residence in the form of a rates notice, drivers license, or similar is required before tyres are placed in the tyre receival area as directed by the weighbridge operator;
- Domestic tyres must be received whole without rims. Rims are to be disposed of separately.
- No more than two (2) domestic tyres can be received at any one time; and
- Residents can dispose of up to eight (8) tyres a year per ratable property.

Commercial Operators – used tyres generated as a result of carrying out a business or trade.

- Contractors must complete and submit to the City via email a “Disposal of Used Tyres Declaration Form” at least one (1) business day prior to disposal. This will be assessed by a City officer and the applicant will be notified in writing of the outcome;
- Upon the Contractor arriving at the Facility, the approved Declaration Form and Controlled Waste Tracking Form must be presented to the weighbridge operator before unloading tyres in the designated receival area;
- Motorbike, Car, 4WD and Truck tyres must be shredded or walls cut and tread halved prior to disposal. These tyres cannot be mixed with heavy earthmoving tyres;
- Heavy earthmoving tyres must be cut into quarters prior to disposal and must be received as stand-alone loads;
- Tyres with rims will not be accepted; and
- Commercial tyres will only be accepted every day of the week between 7:30am and 4:30pm excluding Christmas and Good Friday.
