#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Following the restructure of the KBYC guidelines in 2019, the committee sought new branding and in particular a new logo to better connect with the youth community.

Workshops have been held and the implementation of the new design is being presented for endorsement as the new KBYC logo.

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## REPORT

The KBYC were involved in a rebranding workshop during February 2020 with a local branding consultant. The workshop guided the committee through several

exercises to identify the goals and aspirations of the youth council, highlighting what the committee represents and strives to represent moving forward. The KBYC received a customised branding document from the workshop, outlining their 'brand personality' with suggested colour palette, imagery, typography and general style.

The branding document was utilised as a basis of engagement with an external contractor. Further consultation with the KBYC occurred before three design concepts were presented to the committee. To expand the options, the City's Marketing Department were also engaged to create three possible designs.

The committee have informally chosen the design that aligns best with their purpose, goals and the significance of the KBYC; advocating for young people in the Kalgoorlie-Boulder community.

Main points raised by the committee in reference to the design of choice:

- Multiple different sized speech bubbles representing different opinions and ideas,
- Multiple colours that represent diversity and inclusivity,
- Effective contrast between the youthful imagery and the professional plain text.

The logo design has been approved by the City's Marketing Department and is synergistic with the overall City branding.

## **STATUTORY IMPLICATIONS**

The Kalgoorlie-Boulder Youth Council is a committee established under the Local Government Act 1995 (sec 5.8). The Kalgoorlie-Boulder Youth Council is solely an advisory body and under Section 5.10 of the Local Government Act 1955 requires an absolute majority vote before an appointment of a person to the committee can be made.
