

Development Assistance Unit (DAU)

Objective

The City is committed to assisting you with your development proposals. The City's Development Assistance Unit (DAU) has been formed to provide you with an opportunity to meet with officers from all of our technical departments, at the same time, to discuss your proposal. You can either have a concept that you'd like to discuss or a full set of plans ready to lodge, or anything in between. And, it's free!

Who is in the DAU?

The DAU includes technical officers from Statutory Planning, Building, Environmental Health, Waste and Engineering Services. We can also call in officers from Strategic Planning, Parks & Reserves, Property and the Airport, depending on your proposal. We want to make sure you have access to the right people from the very start.

How does it work?

The DAU meets with customers, by appointment, every Tuesday morning. You can bring along anyone you need, for example, your builder, your designer, etc. We can either meet you in person at the City's offices, or if you're not in the Kalgoorlie-Boulder area, we can call you. The only thing we'll need from you is a copy of your proposal by 12pm on the Friday before the meeting. You can provide this electronically or a hard copy. This gives our officers an opportunity to have a look at your proposal before we meet with you.

What kind of developments is the DAU for?

If you want to speak with us about your proposal, we're happy to meet with anyone. We see the DAU as being most beneficial for large housing projects or commercial/industrial projects. Regardless of the size of the project, we encourage ALL developers to contact us as early as possible so we can help you as much as possible.

Can we meet on site?

Of course! It's probably best to meet around a table first, so we can look at your plans, have a look at our aerial photos and get a feel for your proposal. We can schedule a site visit at the same time.
