

POLICY: DS-HC-003

TRADING IN PUBLIC PLACES – FOOD VEHICLES

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to regulate the operation of food vehicles in the public places of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

DEFINITIONS

STATEMENT

1. No food vehicle shall be granted approval to operate in the central business districts of Kalgoorlie or Boulder as deemed in the current Town Planning Scheme.
2. No food vehicle shall operate in front of any licensed premises outside this area unless the permission of the permit holder has been obtained in writing.
3. No food vehicle shall be permitted to park within 300m of any residence between the hours of 2200 to 0900 hours.
4. No food vehicles shall be granted approval to park in a public area outside the Central Business Districts of Kalgoorlie or Boulder until the City Engineer is satisfied that the location of the vehicle will not pose a traffic problem or a danger to the safety of the general public.
5. The person in charge of the food vehicle shall at all times ensure that the area is kept in a clean and sanitary condition.
6. The applicant must ensure that any odorous fumes produced in the cooking/preparation of food shall not cause an environmental or public nuisance.
7. Should Council receive written complaints in regards to noise, poor hygiene, traffic or disorderly conduct by patrons of the business Council may elect not to renew the trader's permit to trade in a public place. Furthermore if the amount or degree of complaints warrant, Council may elect to cancel the trader's permit at any point throughout the duration of the trader's permit.
8. No food vehicle shall be granted approval to obtain a trading in public place trader's permit unless the vehicle complies with the *Food Act 2008* and the Food Standards Code to the satisfaction of the Manager Health & Compliance.

9. The CEO may waive any of these conditions when the applicant wishes to operate during a fair, function or festival.
